As per your request, the USFWS has completed its survey of the existing powerlines at the Emery Deep Mine.

Although potentially hazardous configuration exist, signs of use by raptors were not noted. Consequently, the Division is accepting the recommendation of the USFWS and will not require Consol to modify the existing power poles at this time. However, should raptor use become evident in the future, Consol may be required to modify certain poles at that time.
