Dear Dave:

As per the request in your letter dated February 19, 1982, approval is hereby granted for construction to begin on the waste disposal site diversion ditch, as shown on plates 15-8 and revised 15-11a, 15-11 and 15-12 (March 29, 1982) of your mine permit application plan. The following regulations will apply during the construction phase.

1. The diversion shall be constructed and maintained in a manner which prevents additional contributions of suspended solids to the streamflow and other runoff in the area. Appropriate sediment control measures will be implemented as needed.
2. Riprap will comply with the requirements of UMC 817.72(b)(1)(iv).
3. Excess excavated material not necessary for diversion channel geometry or regrading of the channel shall be disposed of in accordance with UMC 817.71 - 817.74.
4. Topsoil removed from the diversion excavations shall be handled in accordance with UMC 817.21 - 817.25.

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5. Revegetation of disturbed areas will be accomplished as soon as practicable and in accordance with UMC 817.113 and 817.114.
