On May 20, 1983, a brief partial inspection was conducted at the above-mentioned mine site. I was accompanied on the inspection by Rick Bourdeaux of Consolidation Coal.

The berms protecting Quitchupah Creek and Christiansen Wash appeared to be in good shape. A cursory inspection of the coal stockpile area east of the new sediment pond for the proposed preparation plant indicated that sediment control measures were being properly maintained.

On May 17, 1983 the Division received a letter from Consolidation Coal informing the Division that they had resumed production at the mine on April 18, 1983.
