During December 1982, the Division completed a cursory review of the (Mine Name)'s permanent program permit application and communicated the results of the cursory review to your company. Please refer to the December 6, 1982 Division communication.

It has become apparent to the Division that some confusion may have resulted from our earlier communication due to an error on our part in inadvertently sending copies of the Division's informal ACR comments along with the letter pertaining to administrative completeness. It is our hope to clear up this confusion through the present correspondence.

In the cover letter sent out December 6, 1982, you were informed as to whether or not your permit application was administratively complete. If it was determined that the permit application was administratively incomplete, it was requested that your company reply to only those items which were missing in the original permit application submittal and a listing of those missing items was given. It was not the intention of the Division that your company respond to any potential technical deficiencies enumerated in the informal comments sent out with the letter, but that you respond only to those items necessary to determine administrative completeness. In the near future, the Division will undertake an in-depth Apparent Completeness Review of your permit application after which it should be clear to both parties where actual technical deficiencies occur.
