The Division has completed the review of your deficiency response letter dated March 27, 1987. In that letter you proposed plans to comply with the concerns which were outlined in our March 11, 1987 deficiency letter. Your letter requested an interim approval to allow Consol to proceed with the soil sampling schedule which is planned for the week of April 20, 1987.

The application is now technically complete except for the results of the soil sampling analyses. Consolidation Coal Company has now adequately addressed all other remaining concerns regarding this permitting action.

Upon the Division's receipt of the results of the soil sampling analyses, scheduled for June of 1987, we will likely be in a position to issue final approval for this amendment. Upon your next submittal, please provide twelve (12) complete copies of the approved plans formatted to allow direct insertion into the approved MRP. The March 31, 1987 submittal has been reviewed. The response by Consol is complete and technically adequate. The applicant will obtain soil data April 20 of this year. Following years irrigation management scheme will be revised upon review of the April 1987 soil data. For the 1987 year the applicant will be irrigating at a rate of two inches every 10 to 14 days. No saline horizon development is expected within the root zone with the proposed two inch irrigation schedule.
