Enclosed please find responses to UMC 817.42, 817.43, and 817.49 as requested in your memo of December 5, 1988.

UMC 817.42

Berms and other appropriate structures to provide alternative sediment control will be included with the as-built certification of Pond No. 6.

UMC 817.43

The temporary diversion along the north and west side of Pond No. 6 has a design flow depth of 1.1 feet. Excavation of the structure will provide a minimum cut of 1.6 feet and correspondingly 0.5 feet of freeboard. The text on page 13-4c has been modified to reflect the minimum freeboard.

UMC 817.49

The plan view and cross section of the spillway has been certified by a professional engineer with the requested additional information. Conversation with the department has indicated that the riprap apron design is not required. References in the text have been eliminated.
