SUMMARY:

The operator has submitted an as-built drawing and certification statement for the new bump borehole facilities and pond 006. This submittal is partially in response to the Division's December 5, 1988 memo regarding technical deficiencies in the pump borehole amendment. The submittal is not considered technically adequate at this time.

ANALYSIS:

Stipulation 817.42-(1) - MMD

The applicant has included in the text a commitment to utilize berms and/or catch basins to provide alternative sediment control as required by 817.42. The height and/or dimensions to which these structures shall be maintained must be included in the text or on an appropriate map. The location of these features must be included on plates 13-5 B and C or other appropriate maps.

OPERATOR'S RESPONSE:

The operator has submitted an as-built drawing of pond 006 and corresponding certification statement sufficient to meet the requirements of UMC 817.46 and UMC 817.49. The aforementioned stipulation required the operator to include the sediment control measures implemented at the site to be depicted on an appropriate map. The operator verbally committed to include the required information in the as-built drawing upon completion of construction (personal comm., Chris Jones, December 1988). The submitted

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as-built drawing contains neither the location or dimensions of such structures. Therefore this stipulation is considered outstanding until such time as this information is received. In addition, the operator must revise the appropriate sections of the MRP text to include descriptions and acreages of the proposed small area exemptions as required by the Division's letter of May 10, 1989, regarding TDN X-89-02-107-3, part 1. These revisions should be submitted in a format for direct insertion into the MRP.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Division recommends that the Pump Borehole Amendment be denied final approval until such time as the required information regarding small area exemptions is received.
