Re: Determination of Completeness, Permit Renewal, Consolidation Coal Company, Emery Deep Mine, ACT/015/015, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has conducted an Initial Completeness Review on the information received thru September 5, 1990. The information has been found to be adequate to determine the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) administratively complete. Please submit six additional copies of the MRP to the Division for distribution to other agencies. This should be done as soon as possible to allow for their comments prior to permit renewal.

A technical review of the plan has been initiated. Technical deficiencies will be forwarded to you as individual reviews are completed. Issues raised will need to be resolved prior to January 7, 1991. It is anticipated that the Division will complete the technical analysis review by December 7, 1990.

At this time the applicant should publish a Notice of Application for Permit Renewal as required by R614-300-121. A copy of the publication notice should be sent to the Division as soon as it is available. The Division will notify all other interested agencies and allow for their comment prior to making a final decision to approve or disapprove the renewal application.
