Dear Daron:

During our recent review of the above referenced mine permit, there appears to be two issues that must be addressed by Consolidation Coal Company. One is the need to file R69 Forms for all of the sedimentation ponds that are proposed, particularly in conjunction with the 4th East Portal, and the proposed washer plant. The second item concerns the permitting for any alteration or diversion of natural streams in the permit area. There appears to be an alteration to Quitchumpah Creek in relation to a revised pond outlet works, and also in relation to access to the preparation plant. However, such permits are not limited to just these two particular sites. They must be filed for any stream alteration work.
