3. Topsoil

We looked at the topsoil and subsoil stockpiles near sediment pond 6 that were seeded last fall. These have a moderate number of seedling plants growing on them. The most common plants, however, are grain from the mulch and weeds. I discussed the possible need to fence these stockpiles from cattle that graze in the area. These stockpiles are not particularly subject to erosion, but vegetative cover is needed to retain the viability and usability of the topsoil. Forage in the area is generally of fair or poorer quality, and cattle would be inclined to eat desirable vegetation that grows on the stockpiles. Mr. Bray stated that he would discuss the situation with company officials who would decide whether or not to spend the money to fence the stockpiles. I stated that if the piles are not fenced and if there is evidence that vegetation establishment is being impaired by grazing, enforcement action would be considered.

4. Hydrologic Balance

We checked sediment ponds, alternate sediment control areas, ditches, culverts, and berms and found no problems.

19. AVS Information


I asked Mr. Bray about AVS information updates for the plan which have been forthcoming since about January. This information needs to be submitted as soon as possible.
