Dear Mr. Denning:

This letter is to inform you of recent changes in the general permit for coal mining. While your facility is not covered by that permit, the changes could be expected to be included in the next permit renewal for your facility in May 1994.

The changes included:

1. Total Iron 1 mg/l except where the permittee provides sufficient information that the 1 mg/l dissolved water quality standard will not be violated.
2. The use of gypsum for rock dusting is prohibited unless the permittee adequately demonstrates to the Executive Secretary that gypsum will not significantly increase the total dissolved solids (TDS). The use of gypsum for rock dusting has been identified as a source of increased TDS.
3. Discharge monitoring reports are to be submitted monthly.
4. The state narrative water quality standard paragraph.
5. Storm water pollution prevention plans requirements.
