**3. TOPSOIL -**

The topsoil piles were inspected with no signs of wind or water erosion taking place. The piles have little or no vegetation. These piles have been seeded several times since the establishment of the piles.

**4A. DIVERSION -**

The diversions were spot-checked with no signs of erosion or breaching occurring. The ditches were dry.

**4B. SEDIMENT PONDS -**

The two mine water ponds were discharging. The sediment ponds were dry with no hazardous conditions occurring.

**15. CESSATION OF OPERATIONS -**

This mine could be classified as a non-active mine, since it has not mined or processed, or shipped coal in recent months. The permittee should comply with R645-301-515.320.
