The enclosed revised narrative is to address technical deficiencies identified by your department in their review of our December 12, 2002, "Application For Permit Change". The changes involve information to revise the mining plan of the Mining and Reclamation Plan for the Emery Deep Mine. We offer the following responses to these deficiencies:

1. **R645-301-525.420** THE PERMITTEE MUST UPDATE THE SUBSIDENCE MAPS TO SHOW THE LOCATION OF THE PROPOSED MINE WORKINGS, THE AREAS WHERE SUBSIDENCE IS EXPECTED AND THE AREAS THAT WILL BE PROTECTED FROM SUBSIDENCE.

Revised Plate V-5 of Chapter V has been revised to show the proposed mining orientation along with existing and proposed subsidence monitoring points.

2. **R645-301-521.190**, THE PERMITTEE MUST UPDATE THE MINE MAPS (UG OPERATIONS PLAN, PATE IV-2) TO SHOW THE PERMIT BOUNDARIES AND A COORDINATE SYSTEM SUCH AS UTM, STATE PLANE OR TOWNSHIP AND RANGE.

Revised Plate IV-2, UG Operations Plan. The map has been revised to indicate the Permit Boundary of 015/015, delineate federal leases and time frame old works were mined. State Plane Coordinates as well as Township & Range information has been amended to the map.
