The sediment pond has been inspected by the permittee for the third quarter on September 30, 2005. No hazardous conditions were reported.

**7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments**

The refuse pile was inspected by the permittee and P.E. certified. No hazardous conditions were reported. I inspected the refuse pile and found no hazardous conditions. The permittee conducted the inspection on August 8, 2005.

The area was clear of non-coal waste material.

**18. Support Facilities, Utility Installations**

No new support facilities have been constructed since the last inspection. The permittee will need to fix the wind fence prior to the next inspection.
