Dear Mrs. Grubaugh-Littig:

Please consider this additional information for the above mentioned amendment submitted to your department dated November 12, 2006. Enclosed please find 4 copies including an executed C1 form and a C-2 form. An additional copy has been forwarded to your Price field office.

Since the original submittal Consol has revised and submitted the R2P2 and the LMU to include federal tract U-50044. Due to the fact that BLM will only support full extraction, Consol requests that this submittal be changed to full extraction (planned subsidence). Consol intends to request full extraction (planned subsidence) for the entire permit area in a future submittal. Also the Probable Hydrologic Consequence (PHC) has been revised to reflect full extraction and planned subsidence. The original PHC was compiled in the 1970's and did not contemplate planned subsidence.


