### Bond Increase Required

Consolidation Coal Company currently has on file with the Utah State Office of the Bureau of Land Management two coal lease surety bonds in the amount of \$53,000 and \$5,000 to cover coal leases U-5287 and U-50044, respectively. The surety for these bonds is National Fire Insurance Company of Hartford. The surety bond numbers are 92145724 and 92145723.

Regulations at 43 CFR 3474.3 allow for the amount of any bond to be increased/decreased when additional/less coverage is determined to be appropriate. The Utah State Office, in conjunction with the Price Field Office, is requiring that your bonds for coal leases U-5287 and U-50044 be increased to \$550,000 and \$598,000, respectively based on the anticipated production covered by this leases. In the alternative, a LMU bond may be provided for LMU, UTU-73335, in the amount of \$603,000

These bond amounts may be increased by either riders to the current bonds, or by submitting entirely new bonds for the required amount. Enclosed are forms and instructions for submitting a new bond. If you do not agree with the bond amounts, you must submit written justification to this office clarifying your position for lesser bond amounts.

A compliance period of 30 days from the receipt of this decision will be allowed to submit the above bond riders or bonds.
