- > I spoke with John Gefferth today regarding the upcoming submittal of
- > the hydro section of the Emery Deep MRP. I had asked John if it would
- > be alright if I e-mailed you with specific suggestions we hadn't
- > discussed at our meeting. He said that would be fine.
- >
- > One thing that should be addressed/updated in the MRP is the water
- > rights section. In light of recent water right battles/issues, the
- > Water Rights office has recommended that coal operators produce maps
- > and tables depicting water right information (i.e. priority date,
- > water right number, place of use, point of diversion, point to point
- > diversions, type of water resource, amount of water etc..) for the
- > MRP. I spoke with Marc Stillson at the Price Water Rights office
- > today and he said that his office would be more than happy to sit down
- > with you and show you what they've got in terms of water
- > rights adjacent to and within the Emery Mine permit area. They have
- > adjudication maps on their web-site that would be extremely helpful
- > with this. They can help you find these on their web-site. Marc
- > Stillson's phone number is (435) 637-1303. His office can't produce
- > the map for you, but they could provide you with a lot of information
- > that's readily accessible from their web-site.
