Consolidation Coal Company (CONSOL) hereby provides written notification regarding equipment and material recovery/abandonment, hazardous material inspection and final sealing approval for the portion of the Emery Deep Mine in the area comprising Panels 14 and 15 West and 8 South crosscuts 38 – 56 (I seam) situated on a portion of Federal Coal Lease U-5287.

Please see the enclosed maps and drawings regarding the area of reference, along with final seal locations, and a copy of the MSHA Approval.

On May 16, 2008, prior to sealing the area, a joint on-site equipment and hazardous material inspection was completed by Steve Rigby representing BLM and Russell Hardy CONSOL.
