The mine signs are located at points of public access and contained the required information.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The diversion and culvert outlet by the truck exit and oil storage building are beginning to build with sediment and ice. The grade on this diversion is not allowing for proper drainage, thereby presenting a continual maintenance problem and liability.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

The refuse pile area is snow covered. Pile is stable.

Snow has been removed from road and pad areas.
