Please find enclosed a document titled "Cultural Resource Inventory of Consolidated Energy's Emery Mine Miller Canyon Small Parcel (T22 South, R6 East Section 23) Emery County Utah".

Figure 1 is a 7.5-minute quad map showing the size and location of the Wedge area. A literature search and an intensive 100% pedestrian ground survey (10 meter grid spacing) were conducted on the 14-acre parcel.

No cultural resources were identified in the surveys conducted. The applicant has proposed a determination of "No historic properties affected". The Division concurs with the applicant's proposal and seeks your concurrence with this determination.
