Hi John,

Long time no see. Unfortunately, you're receiving this e-mail because I'm issuing a violation for water monitoring data gaps at the Emery Deep Mine. The NOV will be going out tomorrow, but I thought I'd e-mail you a heads up.

You'd indicated months ago that Richard White was working on revising the water monitoring plan. To that end, one of the abatement measures for the NOV is to revise the water monitoring plan and address some of the sites that clearly aren't producing quality data anymore for one reason or another (e.g. buried by a county road, broken, in-accessible etc.).

The due date for the MRP revision is 60 days from tomorrow on August 29th. Peter Behling indicated in an e-mail to me that due to personnel changes, there were lapses in the data collection. I understand that and I further understand that Peter's now following the water monitoring plan. However, due to Division policy, I had to issue the NOV for gaps in the 4th quarter of 2010.

Give me a call and we can discuss it.
