1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale

The Division will be reviewing the permit transfer by April 14, 2016. Task number is #5058.

2. Signs and Markers

I inspected the identification sign and it meets the requirement of the R645 Coal Rules. See Pictures

3. Topsoil

I inspected the topsoil piles and there were no signs of wind or water erosion. The topsoil piles have berms.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

The future permittee /applicant has cleaned out several culverts and diversions throughout the property. A painted roof bolt was placed in front of every culvert location. All diversions and culverts were performing as designed.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The future permittee will be submitting as-builds for the recently cleaned out sediment ponds. A surveyor will survey the ponds in the next couple of weeks. I inspected the sediment ponds and they were dry. The embankments were stable. No hazardous conditions were noticed during the inspection.

4.c Hydrologic Balance: Other Sediment Control Measures

The future permittee has replaced all the silt fences at the 4th East portals along the fence line.

4.d Hydrologic Balance: Water Monitoring

Water monitoring was scheduled to be taken prior to the end of March.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

I inspected the refuse pile with no hazardous conditions noticed during the inspection. The pad area was graded and diversions were clean of sediment.

8. Noncoal Waste

The site was clear of non-coal waste materials.

16.b Roads: Drainage Controls

Road diversions were clean of sediment and functioning as designed.
