1. Permits, Change, Transfer, Renewal, Sale

The permittee will be submitting an amendment to expand the disturbed area and receive approval for new portal installation.

2. Signs and Markers

The identification signs were inspected and meet the requirements of the R645 Coal Rules. See Pictures

3. Topsoil

I inspected the topsoil piles with no sign of wind or water erosion. See Pictures

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

Diversions and culverts were open. Some sediment has started to fill some of the diversions. This was due to the recent rainstorms. The diversions and culverts are still functioning as designed. Permittee has stated that the diversions will be cleaned out.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

Some of the sediment ponds did contain a small amount of water. It is unlikely that these sediment ponds will discharge. The embankments appear to be stable. No hazardous conditions were noticed.

4.c Hydrologic Balance: Other Sediment Control Measures

Silt fences were inspected and functioning as designed. See Pictures.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

Refuse pile was inspected with no hazardous condition noticed. The refuse pile is very small. No new material has been added. See Pictures.

8. Noncoal Waste


The mine site was clear of non-coal waste material such as trash and oil containers.
