Good morning,

Thanks to Kit for responding so quickly to some missing water quality data.

I've attached the water quality report for 4th quarter 2015. Please note item 5 on the 2nd to last page of the report. There are issues that remain outstanding and require follow-up.

The issues associated with the water monitoring program as a result of impacted monitoring wells has been discussed repeatedly. The last meeting we had to discuss the rehabilitation efforts of the wells and a revision of the water monitoring plan was back in October of last year (October 7th). At that time, we discussed and agreed to the submission of a summary of the rehabilitation efforts of the impacted water monitoring wells as well as a revision to the MRP (specifically the PHC and water monitoring sections). After 8 months, I have yet to receive either of those documents.

I'm going on vacation for two weeks. I'll be back on July 18th. If the requested information has not been submitted by that time, I will issue NOV's for failure to operate according to plan relative to the required monitoring of wells USGS 4-1 and T1-U.
