Good morning,

Thanks for sending the annual report response. I've had a chance to discuss the approach you outlined in your letter with the staff and have a couple things I need to follow up with you on.

1). Priscilla confirmed that she's in agreement with the approach discussed relative to the waste rock sampling data. Once the data is received, please submit that with the mid-term completion response task (#5670) and that way, the data will be incorporated into the MRP.

2). Justin indicated that he's o.k. with not requiring dates on the subsidence maps for Emery Deep. However; the language in the MRP needs to be changed. Chapter V, page 37, bullet 1 discusses how dated subsidence maps will be produced. The language needs to be removed from the MRP if you don't want to produce those maps. That said, please revise the letter you sent us last Thursday. The simplest thing to do would be to revise the 2nd bullet and simply say that a revision to the MRP will be submitted with the mid-term completion response that removes the dated subsidence map language. This way, we can better track why the deficiency Justin identified with the annual report went away with that task (i.e. the deficiency is going to be handled with the mid-term response task as opposed to the annual report task). Does that make sense? Basically just add a sentence or two to the letter in the same manner you did for Priscilla's waste rock sampling deficiency.

Please provide the revised annual report letter to Suzanne as soon as you can before we get too far away from this and have to take time to go back and figure out who said what, did what etc. I hope that make sense.
