I wanted to send a quick e-mail and touch bases with the aforementioned tasks. As you're aware, the Mid-term Response was due today. The As-built drawings are due at the end of this week (November 9th).

Based on the status update you e-mailed us for those two tasks, it sounds like you're thinking an estimated delivery date would be sometime in December. If that is the case, please e-mail the Division and formally request an extension for those two tasks.

I also wanted to inform you that the Division will make ourselves available to discuss any issue(s) associated with either one of those tasks. Recent conversations lead me to believe that outstanding issues remain regarding the bond calculation.

At this point, we are over 6 months beyond the initiation of the mid-term review. If there are bond calculation issues that need to be addressed, we need to get those on table and work towards a resolution sooner rather than later.
