Hi all,

I've been doing some research and I have a couple of pieces of information regarding burrowing owl surveys for you. First, the surveys can begin as early as March 15th. So that is a fairly large survey window you have to work with (Mar. 15-Oct. 31) which should help your timeline for the upcoming year.

However, regarding the frequency of surveys, it looks like they would need to be done every year. As a migratory raptor, we need to treat it as we would any other raptor, which typically calls for annual raptor surveys. We can discuss the finer details later on, but I wanted to get this on everyone's radar now so it doesn't come as a surprise down the road. Let me know if you have any questions.
