On July 16, 1980 a follow up inspection was made by Division personnel, J.C. Helfrich, T.J. Suchoski and D.W. Hedberg at the Utah Power & Light Des - Bee - Dove mines. Division personnel were accompanied by Mr. Larry Guymon, Emery Mining Corporation. Areas addressed were construction of road berms, ditches and small detention basins to control runoff from the main access/haul road, pumphouse area and its accompanying access road. An NOV had been issued, July 10, 1980 during the last inspection period concerning these areas. A number of places were noted along the haul road where berming was not sufficient. Mr. Guymon stated that these areas would be taken care of promptly. Construction of one detention basin in addition to some berming and regrading of the pad area surrounding the pumphouse area had been completed which partially satisfied the concern of Division personnel. A second detention basin with appropriate berming, ditching, riprapping, etc. is to be implemented to control the remaining potential runoff hazard from the main access road to the pumphouse area.

Plans are to be submitted to the Division by the mine operation addressing all surface drainage, control designs, permit boundaries, etc. by September 10, 1980 (refer to previous violation issuance, July 10, 1980).

No new violations were issued.
