Documentation of October 12, 1982, telephone conversation between Dave Lof of the Division and Mr. Val Payne of the Emery Mining Corporation

Mr. Payne called to request an extension on NAOC 82-4-7-1, which was issued at the Deer Creek Mine. This NAOC was in regard to maintenance of the collection drain system on the shop/warehouse parking pad. Because of the large amount of rainfall received during the last week of September, the operator was having difficulty completing the compliance actions required. The operator was granted a two week extension of the deadline. The new deadline date for the NAOC is October 27, 1982.

Mr. Payne also took this opportunity to inform the inspector that the remedial actions required for NOV N82-4-10-1 which was issued at the Church Mine, for failure to maintain drainage ditches and failure to store non-coal waste in a controlled manner, was completed on the morning of September 28, 1982. This can be verified by the fact that a follow-up inspection was conducted by this inspector and John Whitehead on the same date at which time they noted that the remedial actions for the NOV had been completed. Mr. Payne also informed me that the straw bales along the Class I road below the mine site had been repaired and replaced by October 4, 1982.
