The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining has reviewed plans submitted as an abatement to NAOC 81-4-6-4, #1 of 4. Approval is hereby granted for construction of the culvert and catch basin system as shown on these plans for the disturbed drainage at the Des-Bee-Dove Mine. This system will convey disturbed area runoff from the northeast portion of the Desert pad and from the coal stockpile pad to the tipple pad in a nonerosive manner. It should be pointed out that surface damage (the large gully from the coal stockpile to the tipple pad) should be repaired as part of the abatement.

These plans will be included as a minor modification to the interim permit and become a part of the Des-Bee-Dove permit application.
