The above mentioned operation was given a partial inspection on Tuesday, January 25, 1983 by Joe Helfrich and John Whitehead of the Division. They were accompanied by Larry Guymon and Dick Jones of Emery Mining Corporation. The purpose of the inspection was to update the Division on compliance status at the Church Mine operation, as Dave Lof was unable to conduct the required monthly inspection. The following situations were discussed:

1. In reference to an old water tank located above the Des-Bee-Dove portals, Mr. Guymon indicated that this was a pre-law structure and therefore not under the existing permit regulations. Mr. Guymon also indicated that he would check to see if in fact mine responsibilities included the reclamation of said water tank.
2. The berm abutting the drop inlet on the coal storage pad has been repaired, however, Mr. Guymon was not sure that it was adequate at this point in time due to the excessive activity in the area.
