We currently have no problems associated with the storage of sediment where it is presently being located adjacent to the pond, but final approval of your site location and reclamation procedure is contingent on Utah Power & Light receiving approval from State Lands, and approval of an adequate reclamation plan by the Division of Oil, Gas, and Mining.

We currently need Utah Power and Light to address the stability of this material, and provide a map showing the location of the final pile configuration in relation to the location of the sediment pond and local drainage. Utah Power and Light must discuss when they expect this sediment to dry out and how will they protect against erosion of this material.

Please address these concerns as soon as possible. Please do not hesitate to contact us regarding any questions on this matter.
