Dear Mr. Heward:

During the Apparent Completeness Review process, it was requested that the applicant redraw permit area boundary maps for the above referenced mines. The Division would like to take this opportunity to request that, when permit area maps are redrawn, the permit areas should encompass all U. S. Forest Service (USFS) Special Use Permits, all State Special Use Lease Agreements, all Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Right-of-Way Agreement and all areas which are or will be affected by the underground coal mining activities during the terms of the permits. (Please refer to the definition of "permit area" as defined under UMC 700.5.) Specific examples of areas which should be delineated within the permit area boundaries are:


- the sedimentation pond for the Des-Bee-Dove Mine, in State Section 36, under SULA-436
- 104.1 acres encompassing areas utilized for the bathhouse, warehouse site and pump house for the Des-Bee-Dove Mine, under Special Use Permit from the USFS

- the sewage absorption field for the Wilberg Mine, under BLM Right-of-Way Agreement U-37641
- the sedimentation ponds for the Wilberg Mine located on USFS land in Section 27
- the waste rock disposal site for the Wilberg Mine in Section 34, under BLM Right-of-Way Agreement U-37642
