Dear Dr. Nielson:

The Office of Surface Mining (OSM) has received a copy of the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOGM) comments on Utah Power and Light Company's (UPL) response to Federal permit condition number 1 for the Des-Bee-Dove mine. However, we have not received a copy of UPL's submittal in response to that condition. Please have UPL provide us with the appropriate number of copies of its response to Federal condition number 1.

Because OSM is the regulatory authority for coal mining and reclamation operations and activities on Federal lands, we should be provided, by the permittee, the appropriate number of copies of all submittals and other correspondence related to permits for distribution to other Federal agencies and to maintain our records. OSM will coordinate its review, and the review of interested Federal agencies, with Utah DOGM during the processing of the submitted materials. In regard to a permittee's responses to Federal permit conditions, OSM, and other interested Federal agencies, must provide their concurrence prior to approval of the permittee's response.
