Dear Mr. Hedberg:

In response to your letter of January 15, 1985 and to instructions from Ms. Sandy Pruitt today, the following are commitments to your concerns:

1. Rock dissipators will be installed at the following locations by February 22, 1985:

<u>Road Drainage Area</u>	<u>Rock Size</u>
1a & 1b	36"
2	30"
3a & 3b	24"
4	12"

2. 24" rock will be installed as upstream energy dissipators at stations 219, 219+50 and 131 by February 22, 1985.
3. The 22 culverts along the road will be inspected for significant erosion at the outlets and for any culverts plugged with sediment. The inspections will also check for erosion along the length of the road. These inspections will take place during the months of May, July and September in 1985 and 1986. Records will be kept for the two consecutive seasons.
4. Any observed erosion problems will be mitigated within 30 days.

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5. Within 30 days of permit approval, the applicant will submit the scheduled maintenance procedures for the Des-Bee-Dove/Wilberg junction road.
