The Utah Board of Oil, Gas and Mining ("Board") has determined that an emergency exists as a result of the diminishing coal reserves at Utah Power and Light Company's ("UPL") Hunter Power Plant. Petitioner UPL has stated in its Petition that "less than a ten day supply of coal remains at said Hunter Power Plant." In addition, coal cannot be supplied from the Wilberg and Deer Creek Mines due to the December 19, 1984 mine fire which has indefinitely closed those mines.

The Board has determined that immediate action should be taken to enable UPL to increase its stockpiled coal at the Hunter Power Plant from sources including UPL's Des-Bee-Dove Mine.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 40-8-6(c), Utah Code Annotated (1953, as amended), the Board hereby issues the following Emergency Order without notice or hearing which shall be effective upon issuance and shall terminate February 1, 1985 unless extended by the Board.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. That Utah Power and Light may use the so-named Des-Bee-Dove/Wilberg Junction road for access to and hauling coal from the Des-Bee-Dove Mine to the Hunter Power Plant.

2. This Order shall terminate upon February 1, 1985 unless extended by the Board.
