Dear Dr. Nielson:

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Western Field Operations (WFO), has received the June 13, 1986, Utah Power and Light Company's submittal of amendment to the approved mine reclamation plan of Utah permit No. ACT/015/017-86D for the Des-Bee-Dove mine. The amendment is an incidental boundary change to include a sediment pond access road within the permit boundary. OSMRE reviewed this submittal and has determined that it does not constitute a modification to the approved mining plan under 30 CFR 746.18. Based on our review of the submittal, OSMRE concurs with the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOGM's) decision to approve the submittal as indicated in DOGM's letter dated July 7, 1986, and the Federal permit UT-015-1, dated June 20, 1985, is revised accordingly. Please provide a copy of the performance bond, revised to increase coverage for additional disturbance approved under this incidental boundary revision.
