Dear Mr. Whitehead:

As we discussed by telephone Wednesday, July 30th, work to abate the above mentioned Notice of Violation is in progress. Straw bale/silt fence filters have been installed to prevent, to the extent possible, suspended solids from leaving the permit area.

Also, as we discussed, measures to reduce erosion are being implemented. These measures include installation of a conveyor belt curb, construction of a cut-off ditch, erosion repair and soil scarifying. The attached drawing shows the installation of the belt curb.

Completion of the abatement work will, however, not be completed by August 1st. Therefore, I am respectfully requesting a two (2) week extension to August 15th.

Your consideration in this matter is greatly appreciated.
