Dear Dr. Nielson:

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Western Technical Center (WTC), has received the May 9, 1985, Utah Power and Light Company submittal, updated on July 9, 1985, of an amendment to the approved mine reclamation plan of Utah permit No. ACT/O15/O17 for the Des-Bee-Dove mine. The amendment involved erosion control near the Beehive mine substation. OSMRE reviewed this submittal and has determined that it does not constitute a modification to the approved mining plan under 30 CFR 746.18. Based on the review of the submittal, OSMRE concurs with the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOGM's) decision to approve the submittal as indicated in DOGM's letter dated August 5, 1985, and the Federal permit UT-0015, dated October 28, 1985, is revised accordingly.
