Dear Mr. *Val* Payne:

RE: Wildlife Mitigation Plan for Wilberg Waste Rock Site and Des-Bee-Dove/Wilberg Junction Road, Utah Power & Light Company, Wilberg/Cottonwood Mines, ACT/015/019, #3, and Des-Bee-Dove Mine ACT/015/017, #3, Emery County, Utah

The deadline for submission of the wildlife mitigation plan referenced above is extended to April 15, 1986 as requested in your letter of February 26.

I realize that disposition of the Des-Bee-Dove sediment pond road has had a bearing on the plan and that the Cottonwood raptor monitoring plan has a more critical schedule at this time. If the wildlife plan is submitted by April 15, there should be ample time for our review and for consideration by Division of Wildlife Resources. We are still of the understanding that earthwork would be done in spring-summer and revegetation in fall of 1986.

Thanks for keeping me informed even if it is on scheduling problems. We all have other commitments to juggle.
