Re: Request for Justification for Changing Subsidence Monitoring Schedule, Utah Power and Light, Des-Bee-Dove, ACT/015/017, Deer Creek, ACT/015/018, Wilberg Mine, ACT/015/019, Folder No. 2, Emery County, Utah

The 1986 subsidence monitoring report stated that further subsidence monitoring would be done every other year in areas 3, 7, 10 (see pages 7, 12, 15 in the report). However, these areas also noted minor fractures in the ridges in the report (page 22).

Any change in the subsidence monitoring plan require Division approval of an amendment to the plan. Therefore if Utah Power and Light wishes to change the subsidence monitoring schedule, please submit a written request to amend the plan, with appropriate justification.
