From my perspective for the mid-term, I noted all of the structures on site. All of the structures are currently on-site in good repair with the exception of the powder magazine and primer magazine which have been removed. The status of the mine is such that it is easily ready for start up.

My mid-term review comments for this mine will be as follows:

UMC 782.13(b) Identification of Interests-(PGL)

The operator should update the current legal information. The references to Emery Mining Company, for example, are obsolete and must be updated.

The violation status should be updated to the present.

UMC 771.23 Permit Applications General Requirements for Format and Contents-(PGL)

(e)(1) The permit area should be depicted at a scale of 1" = 500' on the permit area map.

UMC 784.13 Reclamation Plan: General Requirements-(PGL)

The reclamation of the Wilberg/Des-Bee-Dove Junction road should be more clearly detailed in the reclamation plan. The reclamation of the access road should also be detailed; i.e., the removal of asphalt and ripping of the road should be described.

The area near the conveyor and upper storage pile should address the removal of all of the coal which seems to be compacted as road base and/or used for construction of the pad.
