Synopsis

This memo will address the items listed in a December 1, 1989 memo from Bill Malencik to Richard V. Smith.

Recommendation

Cottonwood/Wilberg

1. There is need of clarification regarding the portal area or the operator must respond immediately as to why this area is not included in the disturbed drainage area plan.
2. The leach pad must be treated as a disturbed area unless it is totally reclaimed and can be determined a Small Area Exemption (SAE). The operator may want to look at it as a potential ASCA.

Des-Bee-Dove

1. The operator must update the surface facilities map making the necessary changes to bring it into agreement with the current site configuration.
2. Item 2, as described in Bill Malencik's memo to Rick Smith dated December 1, 1989, is not clear as to what changes need clarification and what specifics are needed on these changes before any recommendation can be made. Bill must be asked what items need to be changed.
