The Division received a request on December 27, 1990, to extend the response time for the Des-Bee-Dove Mine Technical Deficiency Document. This 17-page deficiency document was sent December 14, 1990 with a January 4, 1991 deadline date. Mr. Blake Webster (UP&L), stated in his request letter, that he is short-staffed and requests early February for a thorough and complete response to the technical deficiencies.

A Cessation Order was issued to Utah Power & Light Company on September 20, 1990, with two abatement dates: (1) submittal of a complete plan, *and* (2) renewing the permit by January 18, 1991. This plan was determined complete November 16, 1990, *and the first part of the CO terminated 11/20/90.* Renewal of the permit by January 18, 1991, is unlikely due to Division Staff review schedules. If this request for a time extension is granted, the Cessation Order would need to be modified to reflect the new deadline date.

The Division can consider this request as outlined in R614-400-327.100. This request must be documented and then considered for approval or disapproval by the Director or designee of the Director (R614-400-328.300).

Please consider this memo as documentation (along with the attached letter) and then forward and/or approve/disapprove.


Dear Ms Littig:
