Synopsis

This memo discusses the termination of the Mandatory Inspection Program of Des-Bee-Dove Junction Road. A request to terminate this program was received October 1, 1990.

Analysis

This program was set up by the Division following construction of the Haul Road to help the operator prevent future erosion violations and as an abatement plan to a violation. The program has been in place since September 1985 and no obvious concerns have been noted or the problems have been corrected in the field.

It appears that the program is no longer necessary to monitor erosion and drainage controls on the haul road; although, discontinuing this program does not preclude any responsibility on the part of the operator to provide ongoing maintenance.

Recommendation

The Division approves the termination of the requirement to complete the mandatory inspection form for the Des-Bee-Dove Junction Road. This does not preclude the operator from maintaining the site and regular inspections will be conducted.
