Synopsis of Proposal

The Division received the packet of proposed amendments February 1, 1990. The amendments all involve some additions of text concerning ASCAs and the placement of those ASCAs on mine maps.

Analysis

The operator has revised all maps as requested. The ASCAs are clearly represented and labeled on Maps 1-3, 3-7, 3-9, 3-13, 3-16, 4-5 and 5-1, and on the map found in Appendix VII. Each ASCA is described and its particular method of treatment listed on pages 2-10, 2-10.0, 3-30, 3-30.1, 3-30.2, 3-32, 3-32.1, 3-32.2, 3-51, 3-51.1 and 3-51.2 of the new text.

Recommendations

It is recommended that the proposed amendments be approved with no further conditions.
