RE: Reasons for Granting Request for Time Extension to Respond to Technical Deficiency Document, Utah Power and Light Company (PacifiCorp Electric Operations), Des-Bee-Dove Mine, ACT/015/017, Folder #2 and #5, Emery County, Utah

The Division received a request on December 27, 1990, to extend the response time for the Des-Bee-Dove Mine Technical Deficiency Document. This 17-page deficiency document was sent December 14, 1990 with a January 4, 1991 deadline date. Mr. Blake Webster (UP&L), stated in his request letter, that he is short-staffed and requests early February for a thorough and complete response to the technical deficiencies.

Cessation Order #C90-20-2-1 was issued to Utah Power & Light Company on September 20, 1990, with two abatement dates: (1) submittal of a complete plan by November 16, 1990, and (2) renewing the permit by January 18, 1991. This plan was determined complete November 16, 1990. Renewal of the permit by January 18, 1991, is unlikely due to Division Staff review schedules. If this request for a time extension is granted, Cessation Order #C90-20-2-1 will need to be modified to reflect the new deadline date.

The Division can consider this request as outlined in R614-400-327.100. This request must be documented and then considered for approval or disapproval by the Director or designee of the Director (R614-400-328.300).

Please consider this memo as documentation (along with the attached letter) and then forward and/or approve/disapprove.
