RE: Approval of Material Submitted to Satisfy Deficiencies Found During Midterm Review, PacifiCorp, Des-Bee-Dove Mine, ACT/015/017, Folder #2, Emery County, Utah

## SYNOPSIS

In February of 1993, I performed a midterm review of the plan for this site. The only deficiency I found was a discrepancy between the sediment pond inspection and certification requirements as found in the R645 rules and the inspection and certification procedure to which the permittee was committed in the plan. I asked the permittee to correct this discrepancy in a February 22, 1993 memorandum to Pamela Grubaugh-Littig.

On April 5, 1993, in response to my request, the permittee submitted two pages of text which set forth the revised pond inspection and certification procedure.

## ANALYSIS

The revised pages of text are pages 3-20 and 3-20.1. In these revised pages, the permittee commits to: 1) have the sediment pond inspected quarterly by a qualified person; 2) retain a copy of the quarterly inspection report at the minesite; 3) have the pond inspected and certified yearly by a professional engineer; and 4) submit a copy of the annual inspection report and certification to the Division. This procedure is in accordance with the sediment pond certification and inspection procedure as set forth in R645-301-514.300.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the revised pages be approved and included in the Mine Plan.
