Water being intercepted, in the mining operation, is effecting water supplies within the Huntington Creek system. Seals have been placed in the mine and our water is going out of the mine into a different basin drainage.

This letter from Huntington Cleveland Irrigation Company files a protest against PacifiCorp for the Federal Coal Lease readjustment until such time that PacifiCorp reaches an agreement with Huntington Cleveland Irrigation Company, as to any water intercepted in the mining operations dealing with this water problem.

Dear Mr. Jankiewicz,

In reply to your letter of February 14, 1994, in regards to evaluating the application of Coastal States energy Company, UTU-67939, to lease federal land in Carbon County, for coal development.

Huntington Cleveland Irrigation Company hereby enters a protest against this lease. Our reason for this protest, against renewing this lease, is that the water is being intercepted in this mine operation and discharging it out of the mine into a different drainage.

Huntington Cleveland Irrigation Company feels that any mine activity is effecting the springs on the mountain tops, by intercepting water inside the mine, taking out a transbasin diversion thus effecting Huntington Cleveland Irrigation Company's water rights, in the drainage area of the Huntington Creek and Reserviors.

This letter from Huntington Cleveland Irrigation Company files a protest against the renewal of the lease to Coastal States Energy Company until such a time that an agreement can be reached between Coastal States Energy Company and Huntington Cleveland Irrigation Company, dealing with this water problem.
