

**Re: INSTALLATION OF A 15" CMP CULVERT AT DES-BEE-DOVE HAUL ROAD TO ALLOW FOR DRAINAGE OF TEXACO'S PROPOSED DRILLING ACCESS ROAD, PACIFICORP, DES-BEE-DOVE MINE, ACT/ 015/ 017, EMERY COUNTY, UTAH.**

PacifiCorp, by and through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Energy West Mining Company ("Energy West") as mine operator, hereby requests an amendment to install a 15" CMP culvert, 50 feet in length in the existing drainage ditch along the Des-Bee-Dove haul road at the approximate station 204+45. The purpose of this culvert is to allow roadside drainage to flow beneath the drilling access road proposed by Texaco.

Several 15" CMP culverts are located in the same ditch at various locations upstream from the proposed culvert. Each existing culvert is associated with a significantly larger drainage area than that which will report to the proposed culvert. Therefore, a 15" culvert is adequate for this location. The location of the proposed culvert is depicted on the enclosed seven (7) copies of sheet 10 of 38, drawing # CM-10584-DS, packet 5-1, volume 6.


